U.S. luxury cruise line adds voyages to Cuba in 2019 and 2020



Havana, Feb 27 (RHC)-- Regent Seven Seas Cruises has announced that it will be adding more voyages to Cuba on two itineraries in 2019 and 2020.

As the only North American luxury cruise line granted permission to sail voyages to Cuba, the line's Seven Seas Mariner ship will offer the first itinerary to the island during its October 15, 2019, voyage.
