

Cuban Vice President Ricardo Cabrisas meets with Russia's energy minister Alexander Novak



Moscow, May 24 (RHC)-- On the third day of a working visit to Russia, Cuban vice president Ricardo Cabrisas was received by the country's energy minister Alexander Novak. During the cordial meeting, at the headquarters of the Russian Ministry of Energy, the two dignitaries reviewed the bilateral economic agenda.
