

Foreign Minister pays official visit to Barbados



Bridgetown, June 17 (RHC)—Cuba’s foreign minister Bruno Rodríguez Parilla has arrived in Barbados, the last leg of a Caribbean tour that also included Trinidad-Tobago, St. Lucia and Guyana, where he attended the 6th CARICOM-Cuba Ministerial Conference.

Upon his arrival Rodríguez described Cuba’s bilateral relations with Barbados as “very positive and of deep friendship.”

He also visited on Monday the memorial to the victims of the Cubana flight 455 that was blown in midair on October 6, 1976 off the coast of Barbados.

“I paid tribute to the victims of that terrorist action which claimed the lives of 73 innocent people. The barbarism and injustice still hurt,” he said.

The Cuban Foreign Minister will conclude his official visit to Barbados on Tuesday.
