Jose Marti European solidarity brigade starts working visit



Havana, July 1 (RHC) The 49th contingent of the "Jose Marti" European solidarity brigade is starting its yearly working visit Monday, with the demand that the United States put an end to the economic, financial and commercial blockade that it has imposed on Cuba for nearly 6 decades.
