

Wasp Network to be released at the Havana Film Festival



Havana, November 21 (RHC) -- The movie *Wasp Network* by French director Olivier Assayas will be premiered at the 41st International New Latin American Film Festival, the event's organizing committee has announced in the Cuban capital.

Based on the argument of the book *The last soldiers of the Cold War* by Brazilian writer Fernando Morais, the movie tells the story of five Cuban anti-terrorists -Gerardo Hernández, René González, Antonio Guerrero, Fernando González and Ramón Labañino- infiltrated in anti-Cuban groups in the United States to prevent attacks on their country coming from US territory during the 1990's. The co-production between France, Spain, Belgium and Brazil was screened during the 76th Venice International Film Festival and its cast includes renowned Spanish actress Penelope Cruz and Mexico's Gael García Bernal. The film has been successfully screened at important movie festivals, such as Toronto in Canada, San Sebastian in Spain and New York in the United States.

From December 5 to 15, this edition of the New Latin American Film Festival will also include, in the galas section, the films *Emma* ??by Pablo Larraín (Chile); *Parásitos* by Bong Joon-Ho (South Korea); *Chicuarotes* by Gael García Bernal (Mexico); *Marighella* by Wagner Moura (Brazil) and the documentary *Diego Maradona* by Asif Kapadia (United Kingdom).
