Venezuelan President Holds Meeting with Visiting Cuban Foreign Minister in Caracas



Caracas, May 24 (RHC)-- Venezuelan President Nicolas Maduro held a meeting with Cuban Foreign Minister Bruno Rodriguez, who is today concluding a two-day visit to the South American nation.
