



Cuba and other countries congratulate China on its National Day



Havana, September 30 (RHC)-- The first secretary of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of Cuba, Raúl Castro, and president Miguel Díaz-Canel, congratulated China's President Xi Jinping and the people of the Asian nation on their National Day.

In a letter Raúl sent the cordial congratulations and highlighted China's contribution to justice, peace and world economic progress.
