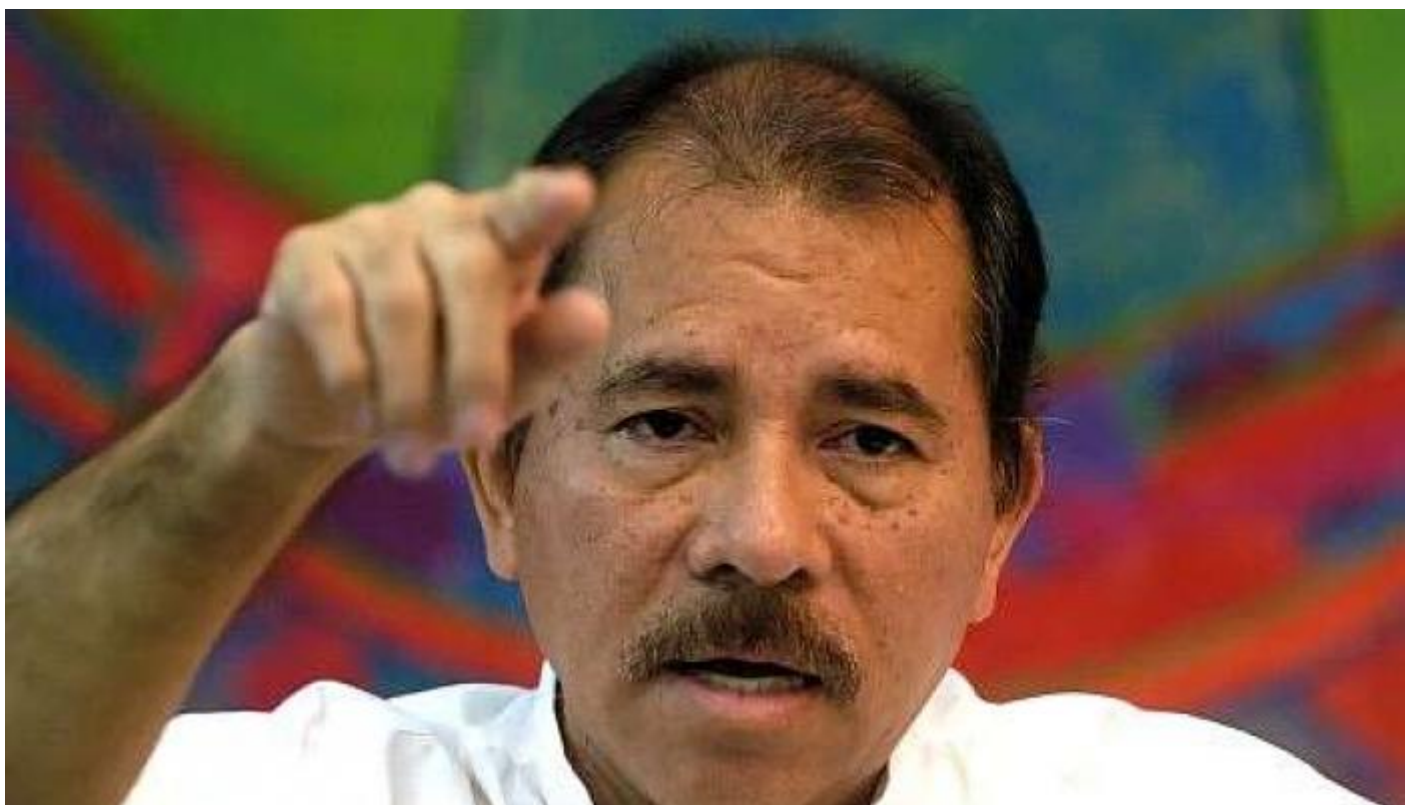


Nicaraguan President Daniel Ortega Arrives in Cuba to Pay Tribute to Fidel Castro
