UN General Assembly Pays Tribute to Fidel Castro



New York, December 20 (RHC)-- The UN General Assembly paid tribute Tuesday to the historic leader of the Cuban Revolution, the late Fidel Castro.

Organized by Cuba's Permanent Mission to the United Nations, the homage paying event was requested by a group of countries on the five continents.
