

Cuban President Raúl Castro Receives Governor Rui Costa dos Santos from Brazilian State of Bahía



Havana, October 31 (RHC-Granma)-- President Raúl Castro met Monday in Havana with Rui Costa dos Santos, governor of the Brazilian state of Bahía, who is attending the Havana International Fair, FIHAV 2017.
