

Solidarity and Aid to Rain Victims in Bolivia



La Paz, February 17 (RHC)— Bolivian Defense Secretary Ruben Saavedra announced the arrival of aid and resources from the United Nations and Panama to help those affected by intense rains.

He explained that Panama has donated two thousand tents to flood victims in the municipality of Trinidad. Saavedra added that three Argentinian doctors arrived to support and provide people with medical assistance.
