Ethiopia and Cuba Strengthen Relations with Presidential Visit



Havana, January 8 (RHC)-- The President of the Democratic Federal Republic of Ethiopia, Mulatu Teshome Wirtu, begins an official visit to Cuba on Monday, according to the Cuban Foreign Ministry.

Ethiopia, the second most populous country in Africa after Nigeria, is one of the founding members of the former Organization of African Unity (OAU) currently known as the African Union (AU).

Its capital, as well as its largest, is Addis Ababa.
