

Noted Cuban writer named director of the Office of the José Martí Program



Havana, September 4 (RHC)-- Renowned Cuban writer Abel Prieto has been sworn in as the Director of the Office of the José Martí Program, that promotes the works of Cuba's National Hero, José Martí.

The ceremony took place at the Center for Martí Studies in the Vedado neighborhood of Havana.
