Bob Woodward's new book depicts Trump White House as "Crazytown"



Washington, September 8 (RHC)-- A highly anticipated book by longtime Washington Post reporter Bob Woodward depicts the Trump administration as an out-of-control operation, with Chief of Staff John Kelly reportedly calling the White House a "crazytown."
