

Cuba and China sign Agreement of Friendship and Collaboration



Beijing, July 16 (RHC)-- Fernando Gonzalez Llort, hero of the Republic of Cuba and president of the Cuban Institute of Friendship with the Peoples (ICAP) began an official visit to the People's Republic of China, aimed at strengthening the historic ties of solidarity and brotherhood between the two countries.

ICAP's President and his counterpart, the president of the Association of Friendship of the Chinese People Abroad (AAPCHE), Li Xiaolin, signed an Agreement of Friendship and Collaboration aimed at strengthening the historic and traditional bonds of solidarity and brotherhood between the two nations.
