

President Diaz-Canel sends message to Cuban boxers



Lima, August 3 (RHC) – The Cuban Boxing squad that recently finished its competition schedule in the Pan-Am Games, received with satisfaction a congratulations message sent by President Miguel Diaz-Canel.

After getting 8 titles out of possible 10, inside the Pan-American ring, President Diaz-Canel tweeted: “Excellent performance of Cuban boxing in Lima. Congratulations to our team and coaching staff. #WeAreCuba #WeAreContinuity”

The message was read by the President of the Cuban Institute of Sports, Physical Education and Recreation (INDER) Osvaldo Vento Montiller in the Miguel Grau Coliseum, in the Villa Deportiva in Callao, Peru.
