Diaz Canel: Washington fails on Venezuela and punishes Cuba with sanctions



Havana, September 7 (RHC)—Cuban President Miguel Diaz-Canel says that because of its failed policies against the Bolivarian Revolution in Venezuela, the United States is showing its outrage by imposing economic sanctions against the Caribbean island.

Lies, slander and hypocrisy are the pretext for the U.S. government to tighten the blockade. We will resist and win, Díaz-Canel wrote on his Twitter account.
