Cuban President Miguel Diaz-Canel arrives in Russia for working visit



St. Petersburg, October 27 (RHC)-- Cuban President Miguel Diaz-Canel arrived in St. Petersburg early Sunday morning to begin an official working visit.

The Cuban delegation led by the Cuban leader was met by the island's ambassador in Russia, Gerardo Peñalver.
