

Cuba expresses solidarity with Bolivian President Evo Morales



Havana, November 9 (RHC)-- Cuban President Miguel Díaz Canel Bermúdez denounced on Twitter the efforts by the opposition to stage a coup d'état in Bolivia against the legitimate president, Evo Morales Ayma.

"Brother President, the Cuban people are by your side against violence and the coup d'état. We strongly denounce the coup attempt," wrote Diaz-Canel on Twitter.

On Saturday, in a press conference from the city of El Alto, President Evo Morales called on patriots, social activists, and public servants to mobilize to defend democracy, and the Bolivian people's vote of October 20.

Morales announced to the Bolivian people and to the entire world that a coup d'état is underway against a democratically elected government and added that the actions are also against social movements, workers, humble people, who have built a democratic and cultural revolution together.
