Cuba and Moscow universities to strengthen cooperation



Moscow, November 22 (RHC)-- The Rector of the Moscow State Technical University of Automobiles and Road Construction, Guennadi Kustarev, and the Counselor of the Cuban Embassy to the Russian Federation, Gustavo Cobreiro, exchanged views on the possibilities of cooperation and exchange in different specialties between the Russian Higher Education and similar institutions of the Caribbean island.
