Foreign minister tells Trump if he wants to support Cuban people, he should lift the genocidal blockade




Havana, February 5 (RHC)--The president of the United States, Donald Trump, insisted this Tuesday on his interfering attitude in the internal affairs of Cuba, Venezuela and Nicaragua.
