

Cuban Soccer Association in talks to readmit player competing abroad



Havana, (RHC) – The Cuban Soccer Association (AFC) is one step away from re-admitting in the national team players hired in foreign leagues, as did volleyball, baseball and handball.

The call to the Cuba team of soccer players who are currently playing in foreign leagues has been made. The measure has the approval of the Cuban Sports Institute (INDER) and the players' union. "We have good experiences in volleyball and baseball. Now in athletics we approach the same situation," said the head of the Volleyball Federation and a "key player" in the return of the players. "The technicians (of Cuban soccer) must make an assessment of the players and their situation."
