Angela Merkel to self-quarantine after her doctor tests positive for COVID-19



Berlin, March 24 (RHC)-- German Chancellor Angela Merkel said she was self-quarantining after her doctor tested positive for coronavirus, as the country barred groups of more than two people from gathering, with the exception of families.

Chancellor Angela Merkel told reporters: "The overwhelming majority of people understand that it's now down to every individual, that everybody can and must do their bit to stop the virus. ... That's how we show that we care for older people and the sick, for whom the virus is the most dangerous. In short, that's how we save lives."
