Cuba reports 15 new cases of COVID-19 over the past 24 hours



Havana, May 23 (RHC)-- The National Director of Epidemiology of the Cuban Ministry of Public Health, Dr. Francisco Duran, reported that there were 15 new cases of COVID-19, for an total of 1,931 positive cases across the island.

During his daily press briefing held Saturday morning, Dr. Duran said that over the past 24 hours -- up to 12 midnight Friday night -- fortunately, no patients died from the coronavirus. A total of 81 patients have died from COVID-19 in Cuba over the past several months.

To date, 1,671 patients have recovered -- with an additional 40 patients released from hospitals during the day on Friday.
