

Council of Ministers discusses economic measures for post COVID-19 stage



Havana, June 10 (RHC)-- The Council of Ministers is examining this Wednesday, in an extraordinary session, measures proposed by the Political Bureau of the Communist Party to advance in a first stage in the Cuban economic recovery after COVID-19.
