Canada still talking to U.S. about future of ban on non-essential travel



Ottawa, July 14 (RHC)-- Canada and the U.S. are still in talks on the future of a ban on non-essential travel between the two countries and will have more to say in the coming days, Prime Minister Justin Trudeau has said.

The ban, introduced in March, has been extended several times and is due to expire on July 21st. Trudeau also told reporters he had talked to U.S. President Donald Trump earlier in the day and reiterated his opposition to the possible imposition of tariffs on Canadian aluminum exports.
