

Cuba reports 48 new cases of COVID-19



Havana, September 29 (RHC)-- The National Director of Epidemiology of the Cuban Ministry of Public Health, Dr. Francisco Durán, reported on Tuesday 48 new cases of Covid19 during the last 24 hours for a total of 5,536 since the beginning of the epidemic.

During the daily media briefing, the specialist stated that 7,298 patients had been admitted to the island's isolation centers and hospitals by the end of the day of which 541 were confirmed cases.

Duran explained that on Monday, the island's labs tested 7 thousand 424 samples.

All diagnosed patients are Cuban, and 43 of them are confirmed case contacts.

By province, 30 cases were from Havana, 7 from Ciego de Avila, 9 from Sancti Spíritus and 2 from Matanzas.
