Cuban industry is working on some 200 science and innovation projects

Havana, March 25 (RHC) The Cuban Ministry of Industry is currently leading some 200 science and innovation projects, according to a meeting between President Miguel Díaz-Canel and Prime Minister Manuel Marrero with experts and scientists linked to the sector.

At the meeting, the Minister of Industry, Eloy Álvarez, presented the concepts for the work in this area and the main results achieved to modernize the national industry in a gradual and sustained manner, according to the Presidency's website.
