

Cuba Assembles Biotechnology Plants in Other Nations



Havana, June 9 (RHC)-- Cuba's Biopharmaceutical Laboratory Business Group (LABIOFAM) is working on the design, construction, assembly and launch of biotechnology plants in countries like Ethiopia and Tanzania, after doing so in Venezuela, China, Vietnam and Argentina, among other countries.

These efforts will be shown during the LABIOFAM 2014 International Congress, scheduled for September 22nd through the 25th at Havana's Convention Center, according to Jose Antonio Fraga, director of the entity.

Attending the meeting will be entrepreneurs and health and agriculture ministers of several countries, representatives of international organizations and delegates of Spain, China, Russia, Rumania, Peru, Mexico, the United States, Bolivia and Chile, among other nations.
