FM: The US has no political or moral authority to speak about Cuba



Havana, July 12 (RHC)—Cuba's Foreign Minister Bruno Rodriguez Parrilla rejected statements by the UN National Security Advisor Jake Sullivan.

On Twitter, Rodriguez stated that the White House National Security Advisor has no political or moral authority to speak about Cuba.
