

Over 2 million Cubans fully vaccinated against COVID-19



Havana, July 16 (RHC)--Health authorities announced on Friday that Cuba surpassed the figure of 2 million people who have been fully vaccinated with the anti-COVID injectables developed by the island's scientific community.

International media confirm that Cuba is currently the nation with the highest daily vaccination rate per 100 inhabitants.

According to statistics from Oxford University, the island is currently above the world average both in the number of people who have received all doses of vaccines and in the number of people who have received at least one dose.

The Ministry of Public Health anticipates that by the end of 2021, all the island people will be vaccinated. At the close of July 14, 7,900,125 doses of Cuban vaccines had already been administered, which means that at least 3,220,481 people have received at least one dose of one of the vaccines Soberana 02 and Abdala.
