
Lizt Alfonso Dance Cuba invites children and youngsters to workshops



Havana, September 9 (RHC)-- The Lizt Alfonso Dance Cuba (LADC) company has invited children and young people to participate in its vocational workshops to learn the fusion dance that is the flagship style of the prestigious company.

According to a press release issued by the institution, registrations will take place as from September 14 at its headquarters and are open to students between the ages of 5 and 13.
