Cuban president says visit of Panamanian foreign minister was significant



Havana, Jan 31 (RHC) Cuban President Miguel Díaz-Canel said the official visit to our country of the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Panama, Janaina Tewaney Mencomo was very significant.

According to the Presidency's website, the meeting took place at the Convention Palace, after the participation of the Cuban president in the inauguration of the International Congress Pedagogy 2023.
