

Cuba denounces US violation of human rights through sanctions against Cuba, Iran and Syria



China denounces United States violation of human rights

Havana, March 28 (RHC) China denounced this Tuesday that during 2022 the United States committed human rights violations. A report by the Information Office of the State Council (Cabinet) referred to the imposition of these measures against Cuba. China defined the United States as the most prolific sanctioner in the world because "it has measures to restrict the economic, financial and trade relations of other countries." In the case of the Caribbean island, the report deplored the persistence of the economic, financial and trade restrictions. "On November 3, 2022, the General Assembly of the United Nations Organization voted for the third time to condemn the United States for its policy of economic, financial and trade sanctions against Cuba." At another time, the article mentioned Washington's refusal to close the prison opened at the Guantánamo Bay. It deplored the sending to prison of some 780 individuals without trial and the inhumane treatment to them. Likewise, the Chinese text recalled that last year independent experts from the UN Council on Human Rights reported that the United States had violated human rights. The six-part Cabinet document listed facts, figures, and the opinions of experts and international organizations.
