Concerts at Basilica Minor of St. Francis of Assisi continue in May

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Havana, May 13 (RHC)-- The Museum of Sacred Art of the Minor Basilica of the Convent of St. Francis of Assisi continues today with its May cultural program and its most emblematic themes of romanticism,
