Cuban President Miguel Díaz-Canel arrived in Serbia?

Belgrade, June 20 (RHC)-- Cuban President Miguel Díaz-Canel on Tuesday arrived in Serbia to conduct a comprehensive program as part of his official visit till coming Wednesday.

The Cuban leader was welcomed at Nikola Tesla Airport by Deputy Prime Minister and Defense Minister Miloš Vučević.

Díaz-Canel arrived in Serbia from Italy where he met with his Italian counterpart Sergio Mattarella, Italian businessmen, as well as with Qu Dongyu, director-general of the UN Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO).
