
Cuban President congratulates his counterpart from Mexico



Havana, July 2 (RHC)-- Cuban President Miguel Díaz-Canel congratulated his Mexican counterpart, Andrés Manuel López Obrador, whose fifth year since his electoral victory was celebrated on Saturday.
