Havana, July 4 (RHC)-- Cuba will be present at the International Music Festival of Rudolstadt, Germany, set for July 6th through the 9th. Singer-songwriter Tony Ávila will be part of the Cuban delegation.

The author of hit tunes like 'Mi casa.cu' and 'Timbiriche' resorted to social media to express satisfaction with this new opportunity to take his art and Cuban culture to world stages.
