

Vietnamese Leaders Voice Solidarity with Cuba



Hanoi, September 12 (RHC) — The Secretary General of the Communist Party of Vietnam, Nguyen Phu Trong, expressed his support and solidarity to Cuba as he welcomed Cuban Foreign Minister Bruno Rodríguez, who concluded an official visit to that South East Asian country on Thursday.

During the meeting, Nguyen sent his regards to Cuban President Raúl Castro and said Rodríguez's visit helps to strengthen bilateral ties, which have had a solid foundation throughout history and have become evident through mutual cooperation in several areas.
