

Protesters disrupt Harvard-Yale football game to call for Gaza ceasefire



New Haven, November 22 (RHC)-- In New Haven, Connecticut, hundreds of students and alumni from Yale and Harvard brought a football game between the two universities to a halt for nearly two hours Saturday as they called for a ceasefire in Gaza.

Protesters waved Palestinian flags and banners that read “End the Occupation; End the Genocide” and “Free Palestine.”

Protesters demanded that there be a ceasefire in Gaza and that Yale and Harvard divest from weapons manufacturers that supply Israel’s military.
