
Diaz-Canel says the Revolution is our greatest work of love

Havana, February 14 (RHC) -- Cuban President Miguel Diaz-Canel today stressed on his X account that the Revolution is the island's greatest work of love, on the occasion of the celebration of the Day of Love and Friendship.

The president stressed on the social network that love is the engine that drives Cuban revolutionaries. "Cuba is Love, and from here we also extend it to our beloved Palestine".

For his part, the president of the National Assembly of People's Power (parliament), Esteban Lazo, sent congratulations to the Caribbean nation and recalled Marti's premise referred to that "the only strength and the only truth there is in this life is love.
