Cuba will host 12th International Congress of Science Education



Havana, March 16 (RHC) Cuba is finalizing details to host from next 25 to 28 the 12th International Congress on Science Education and the 17th International Workshop on the Teaching of Physics, at Havana's Convention Palace.

According to the island's Ministry of Education, the meeting will feature the participation of researchers from Colombia, Brazil, Guatemala, Ecuador, Spain and Venezuela.

The president of the scientific committee of Congress, Alexis Méndez, explained that there will be an exchange on the teaching and learning process of natural, exact and technical sciences in general and higher education, and in non-formal education.
