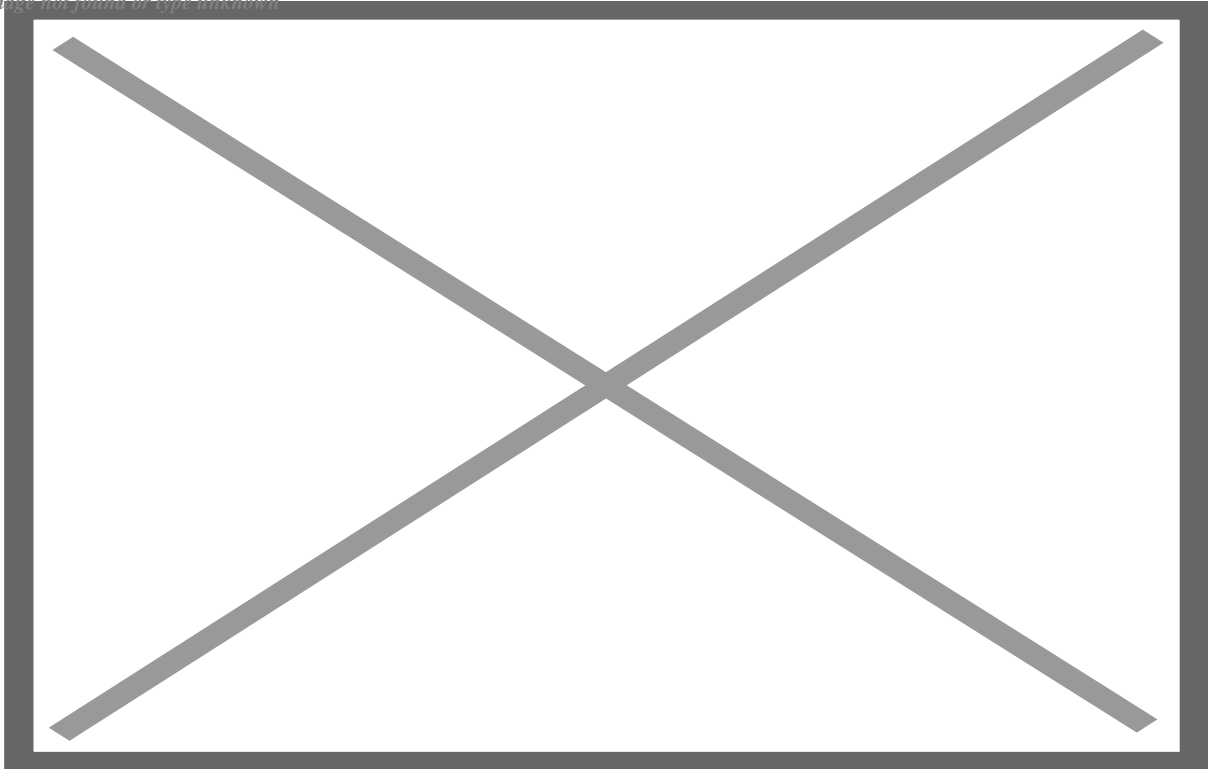


Cuba decrees Official Mourning for death of Iranian president
