Havana, September 10 (RHC) --The First Secretary of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of Cuba and President of the Republic, Miguel Díaz-Canel, received on Tuesday Susana Sottoli, regional director for Latin America and the Caribbean of the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), who is on a working visit to Cuba.
