

Cuba issues call for 7th Conference for the Balance of the World in 2027

Havana, February 1 (RHC) -- The World Council of the José Martí International Solidarity Project has issued the call the 7th edition of the International Conference for the Balance of the World, which will take place in Havana in January 2027.
