The Pentagon has accepted a \$400 million luxury Boeing jet from Qatar, which will eventually be used as a new Air Force One.

Washington, May 23 (RHC)-- The Pentagon has accepted a \$400 million luxury Boeing jet from Qatar, which will eventually be used as a new Air Force One.

Ethics experts have raised concerns over the legality of the gift, as well as the cost of retrofitting the plane, which could cost upwards of \$1 billion.

The aircraft will eventually be transferred to Trump's presidential library, where he can continue using it after leaving office.

Senate Republicans on Wednesday blocked a bill authored by Democratic leader Chuck Schumer that would have barred the Pentagon from spending any taxpayer money on the jet.
