## Forty-fourth edition of the Caribbean Festival begins in Cuba



Havana, July 3 (RHC) The 44th edition of the Caribbean Festival, also known as the Fire Festival, begins today in the city of Santiago de Cuba, this time with a focus on the popular culture of Curacao.
