Horta Debuts with Triumph in Boxing Tournament in China

Havana, July 11 (RHC) - The world runner-up champion Saidel Horta (57 kg) debuted today with a triumph in the traditional boxing tournament in the Chinese city of Guiyang.

Recovered from health problems that kept him away from competitive activity, the Antillean took credit 5-0 over the Filipino Eljay Pamisa in an adverse day for two of his teammates.

According to the information from the headquarters, he controlled the times and the fight in general, with a sustained dominance in all the orders during the three rounds.

The delegation's report also highlights the work of Meliza Millares (60 kg), despite her 2-3 setback against the Belarusian Valeriya Zaitzava.

The technicians of the Island saw her better in the opening round, losing the intermediate round and recovering enough in the closing round to win the decision, but the judges did not find it enough and the European celebrated her success.

The other decision matched the predictions, with the host of the orb subtitle Tuohetaerbieke Tanglatihan (80 kg) becoming a 5-0 defeat of Maruán Roque.

The Caribbean started at a good pace, but his opponent, victim of the star Arlen Lopez in the planet event, responded quickly and accurately based on his greater experience to impose authority in the three segments.
