

Cuba's national holiday celebrated in Palestine



Ramallah, July 26 (RHC)-- The Palestinian-Cuban Friendship Association highlighted this Saturday the example that the Caribbean island and its Revolution represent for the peoples of the world and

celebrated the Day of National Rebellion in that country.

"On this momentous date in Cuba's history, we address you, brothers and sisters, with a greeting of respect and loyalty," the organization expressed in a message sent to the Cuban Institute of Friendship with the Peoples.
