

Angolan Defense Minister Congratulates Cuban Armed Forces



Luanda, December 4 (RHC) — Angolan Minister of National Defense, João Gonçalves Lourenço, congratulated the Revolutionary Armed Forces of Cuba on the 58th anniversary of their foundation and thanked Cuba for its support of Angola.
